Covid-19 Mitigation Plan 2021/2022

(revised March 10, 2022)

Mitigation Plan to Limit Student Exposure and/or Spread for In-Person Learning

Students/SCDS Staff may wear face masks/covering.

No AM care program. PM Care limited to 20 students based on pre-sign up.

Students will be dropped off outside of the school building (8:00AM earliest drop off).

No parents allowed inside the school building, unless advanced approval from SCDS office.

Teachers will report students to the office who exhibit a temperature of 99F or higher, coughing, and/or sneezing.

Posters around school will promote handwashing and other good health practices.

Exterior bathroom doors to remain open to reduce touch points.

Individually assigned technology such as iPads and Chromebooks for use at SCDS. No sharing.

Water fountains will only be operational for filling water bottles (touchless) and not directly drinking from. Each student **MUST** bring a water bottle to school each day.

Parent Responsibilities

Parents **SHOULD NOT** give fever reducing medication before sending a child to school.

Parents should notify SCDS if their child has a sickness of any kind.

Parents should quarantine their child, if their child has been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19 or who have shown symptoms of Covid-19, for 5 calendar days with a negative COVID-19 test or 10 calendar days after a positive COVID-19 test or from the onset of symptoms. Day 0 is day of contact, positive test or onset of symptoms. Parents should notify SCDS of exposure and/or student in quarantine.

Parents should be available or have someone available on their emergency list to pick up their child within 30 minutes of notification, should their child develop or show COVID-19 symptoms and be required to leave school.

What happens when there is a positive COVID-19 case?

If a student exhibits symptom of COVID-19 at school, the student will be sent to the office and isolated. The student's parent will be called to pick up their child within 30 minutes.

If a teacher exhibits symptoms of COVID-19 at school, the teacher will be isolated and sent home as soon as possible. The class will be supervised by an SCDS staff member.

If a student or SCDS staff member is confirmed to have COVID-19, parents in the class will be notified.
